

Co-Teaching Group Project:

Students will be broken into groups and will be responsible for conducting a co-teaching lesson utilizing their assigned co-teaching method. Students will choose two individuals from the group to be the general and special education teachers. Your group is to teach to the whole class, so be prepared for 30 students. The additional students in your group will be required to have a part in your lesson that demonstrates how you will work with the special education students. This most likely means that at least two of your group members will be SPED students, so they need to be prepared to have behavior problems or academic problems.

In addition to preparing a 30-minute lesson utilizing your assigned co-teaching method you will be required to complete a lesson plan (See *Appendix C* for the template). Your lesson can be over any grade level and subject you choose. One person from each group will upload the lesson plan into LiveText. Make sure when you are teaching your lesson that you appropriately convey your co-teaching model to the class.

This assignment is worth 20 points for your project **PLUS** an additional 5 points from your group members (group participation grading form) for a total of **25 points**.

Your grade will be based on the following (See *Appendix D* for grading rubric):

- 1) Preparing an introduction reminding the class about your co-teaching method and set up your lesson. Additionally, your introduction will provides information when this style may best be used in the classroom.
- 2) Completing the lesson plan template found in *Appendix C*
- 3) Completing a group member rating scale regarding participation in group work. *See Appendix E*
